Today during our INSET day teachers thoroughly reviewed the school's Risk Assessment to ensure that we are doing everything possible to reduce risk and a few minor changes were made. This will now be shared with all staff to ensure confidence and fidelity to the plans we have put in place.

For parents we would like to remind you and request support with the following;

- If your child is showing any symptoms of Covid please keep them at home and request a test
- Take your child's temperature before school. A 'temperature' is over 37.7°
- Socially distance from other parents at pick up and drop off
- We request that parents don't drive down Badgers Close for the safety of the children using the field gate
- Send your child to school with suitable layers of clothing under their school uniform. We will have the heating on but the rooms must continue to be well ventilated and the winter is here
- If you are able to, we would gratefully receive boxes of tissues for the classrooms. Cold season is upon us and we can go through many, many boxes as you can imagine

Today you should also have received a letter regarding Key Worker status. All letters and the risk assessment are to be found on our website.
