Children and their use of social media

Loxwood School is part of a locality group of schools, all of which feed into The Weald Secondary School. There are 9 primary schools within the group and we work closely together to improve and develop provision within our schools. As you will be aware from national news there is a growing concern about the increase in instances of children mis-using social media. This includes children as young as years 5 and 6. This can then intensify in secondary school. At Loxwood we have not had any significant instances brought to our attention, however an audit of your child's usage may highlight something that you were unaware of. Below are some of the concerns raised by local headteachers and a few suggestions you may wish to investigate

- Year 5 & 6 children using Facebook, Instagram (legal age for an account is 13) or Whatsapp (16) the setting up of these accounts has meant that a child has already lied on line about their age, a particular risk if their accounts are public.
- Children messaging each other late at night it is advised that children 'hand –in' their devices prior to bedtime
- Some parents are unaware of their children's online activity there are a range of apps that can be used to track your child's usage

We will continue to teach the children about e-safety as part of the national curriculum to support your child in keeping themselves safe on line.
