Dear Parents and Carers of Year One,

Your child is in Year 1 Hub 2 Classroom 1 School is open Monday to Thursday

You have indicated to us that you would now like your child to return to school. We very much look forward to seeing you on Monday. Below is the information that you will need

- 1. Please ensure that you have read the risk assessment
- 2. We ask that your child attends school on every day that they are offered (Monday to Thursday). We are not offering part time or a flexible approach. This system would be too complex to staff and could be detrimental to the procedures we have put in place to reduce risk

School times: Gate open from 8:40 to 9:00. This is to stagger arrivals and ease congestion on the road Pick up: as per usual 3:05 for infants.

Drop off

All Year One Children must arrive via the infant side gate. We have put a one-way system in place so that you will arrive down the alleyway, come through the gate, drop your child at the classroom door and exit via the big green infant gate by the year 2 classroom. If at all possible only one parent must drop off their child. Please maintain social distance from other adults.

A teacher will greet you at the door. This will be your child's hub and as far as possible staff will remain the same.

Pick up

Please enter the premises in the same way and collect your child from the classroom door. Please only one parent to pick up. Please maintain social distance from other parents.

Uniform

All children must wear a clean school uniform every day. If your child has PE one day we will inform you and they are to arrive in school in PE kit.

No book bags, toys or resources from home are to be brought in.

Lunch and snack

The dead line for ordering a hot meal for Monday has passed (you may have already informed us of your intent to have a meal prior to starting and this will be ordered). If you now wish to have a hot meal please let the office know by Friday 19th for your meals to start on 29th June. If you have not ordered a meal, packed lunches must be in a hard wipeable lunch box. A reusable plastic water bottle must be provided. These can be refilled throughout the day. You will need to provide a snack for your child.

This is all very different but I want to reiterate that our commitment to your child's welfare is still our highest priority. Although adjustments have been made to how we are able to teach this will not make a difference to the staff's dedication to your child's well-being and safety whilst at school.
