



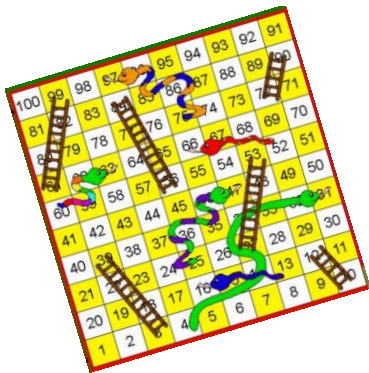

Design and make a board game with a fair trade theme. Bring it in to play with your friends.



- *Observing & Recording*

Listen to some sea shanties, then make up your own to perform to the class.



- *Prepare poems and plays to read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone and volume so that the meaning is clear to an audience.*

Container ships carry heavy loads. Make a paper boat suitable for carrying a 1kg load.



- *Develop a range of practical skills to create products (such as cutting, drilling and screwing, nailing, gluing, filling and sanding, painting and constructing).*

Create a fact file on Sir Francis Drake. Include key elements of his life.



- *Describe the social, ethnic, cultural or religious diversity of past society.*
- *Describe the characteristic features of the past, including ideas, beliefs, attitudes and experiences of men, women and children.*
- *Write non-chronological reports -include headings, sub-titles, pictures, third person, technical vocabulary, past tense.*
