Dear Parents,

Hi all – what another fantastic week we have had. This week we have had: children building houses for the 3 little pigs; trying out the skill of 'Frottage' created by Max Ernst in art; maps showing Stick Man how to get to our school and making friends to keep him company; choreographing their own machine style dances; coding with Scratch and finding major rivers in the world using co-ordinates in an atlas. It has been a very busy week.

Changes to the self-isolation period for those who test positive for COVID-19:

We have just received an update from the Government.

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace. If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

Mr Green PE Wednesday:

The children absolutely love having Mr Green every Wednesday. Unfortunately, he is only able to fit 6 classes in on his day with us, which means that every half term, one class will not go out with him. If it is your child's class that is missing his session, then they do not have to come in their PE kit on that day.



NHS Scanner App:

The NHS have launched a food scanner app making it easier for families to find healthier foods and drinks options when shopping. If this is something that would interest you, please pick up a leaflet from the front entrance hall.

Car park:

I have noticed that some of the younger children, whilst waiting for older siblings, like to chase around the cars in the car park. For health and safety reasons and to also stop distractions for our Year 5 class at the end of the day, please can we ask that younger children refrain from doing this.
