School Vision

To ensure we promote and support the importance of a healthy lifestyle and place particular emphasis on the wellbeing of our students and how sport and activity impacts positively on all aspects of school life.

The targeted and strategic use of the Primary School Sport Funding will support us in achieving our vision.

Principles

The purpose of this funding is to ensure improvement in the quality of sport and PE provision for all children. (Department for Education, March 2013)

We will ensure that sport and PE provision addresses the needs of all of pupils, including those who belong to disadvantaged, vulnerable and gifted groups.

Primary School Sports funding will be allocated following a whole school needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups and individuals. In order to address any (identified) areas of need, this funding may be used across particular classes, key stages or whole school at any time during the 2 academic years 2013-14 and 2014-15.

Provision

The range of provision the Governors may consider making includes the means to reduce the gap in skills between individuals and increased pupil participation in sports.

Additional teaching and learning opportunities are to be provided through:

- Professional development courses
- Cover release for professional development
- Quality assured CPD modules/materials
- Specialist Sports teaching
- Qualified Sports coaching
- Sports competitions
- Trips to professional matches/games
- After School sports clubs
- Holiday sports clubs

All our work will be aimed at increasing attainment, participation, improving confidence and skills and encouraging a life-long love of sport together with an understanding of the health benefits participation in sports activities offers.

Reporting

It will be the responsibility of the Headteacher, the school PE Coordinator and the Governor overseeing PE to produce regular reports for the Governors' Finance sub-committee on:

- progress made towards improvements, by year group.
- an outline of the provision that was made since the last meeting
- an evaluation of the cost effectiveness, in terms of the progress made by the pupils receiving a particular provision, when compared with other forms of support

It will be the responsibility of the Chairperson of the Resources committee to ensure this information is made known to the full governing body.

The Governors of the school will ensure that there is an annual statement to parents on how the Primary Sport Premium Funding has been used to improve the uptake and outcomes for PE/sports both within and beyond the school day. This task will be carried out within the requirements published by the Department for Education.

Appeal

Any appeals against this policy will be through the governor's complaints procedure.
