### **Teach Your Monster to Read App**

FREE to download until Sunday 17th January. We highly recommend this Government approved app for teaching children phonics, spelling and sentence reading. It is aimed at children in their first stages of reading (Acorns, Year 1 & 2) or older children that need a bit more practice. It is always free to use from a desktop computer or laptop but the app usually has a charge. However, until Sunday there will be no charge for downloading the app. Once it is downloaded, even after the free downloadable period ends, the app will carry on being free to use.

# **Learning Time**

For Primary School children the expectation is "an average of 3 hours" in KS1—age dependent and 4 hours for KS2. We are setting work appropriate to this.

However, because everyone has different circumstances the timetable for this is fairly flexible. Please take your lead from your individual class teacher for the fine detail. Remember that the children in school are also being given plenty of breaks and we do not expect your child to be sitting at a table for 4 hours solid.

The benefits of Tapestry are that your child's learning will be stored in their own electronic portfolio which can be linked to the national curriculum by the class teacher and be used to help with our assessment of your child.
