This year, we will hold our very own Bake-Off at the fair. Children can make biscuits, cakes, cup cakes, whatever they fancy along the theme 'Circus'. Entries must be brought on the day please, labeled with the child's name and age.

Cake donations

So we are doing what we did last year, to prevent wastage; please can we ask just for homemade or home decorated cakes from the children to be entered into the Bake-off.
