In English we plan to focus on...

Reading a range of non-fiction texts to research transport in the past.

Reading and discussing topic related stories.

Writing for different purposes e.g. simple recounts, fact books, posters, chronological reports, instructions and poetry. Revising all graphemes previously taught and beginning to learn the correct choice of digraph for particular words. Revising letter formation and handwriting joins learned and using correct sizing for letters.

Revising Year 1 common exception words and beginning to learn Year 2 words.

Key texts: Mr Gumpy's Motor Car, The Gingerbread Man, The Journey, Mrs Armitage on Wheels, Whatever Next, Taking Flight.

In Maths we plan to focus on...

Reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
Recognising the place value of two-digit numbers and

comparing and ordering numbers using <> =.

Counting in steps of 2,3,5 and 10 from any number.

Using number facts to 20 and related facts to 100.

Adding and subtracting two and one digit numbers using apparatus, pictures and mental methods.

Recognising and naming common 2D and 3D shapes.

Identifying the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, eg edges, faces etc.

Identifying lines of symmetry for 2D shapes.

Sorting shapes according to their properties.

In History we plan to focus on...

Using secondary sources to research transport in the past and learning about significant people.

Retelling the story of the first ever flights.

Drawing simple timelines and placing events in

chronological order.

Comparing past and present transport in our locality. Observing and investigating historical artefacts and sources.

Asking questions to find out about the past.

Identifying similarities and differences between ways of life including their own.

Naming different types of materials.

Identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for different uses.
